The family history dates back to 1927 when the Puget-Brunet, who were shopkeepers at the time, purchased their first vineyards in Aÿ. Over the years they acquired additional south-facing vineyards in the villages of Mareuil-sur-Aÿ, Mutigny and Fontaine-sur-Aÿ, planted exclusively to Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. In 1999 Champagne Dallancourt was founded in Èpernay by Virginie Dallancourt and her husband Antoine Lutun. *Agriculture Raisonnée* is practiced in all vineyards minimizing their impact on the land and only first press juice is used in the *assemblage* of all their cuvées.
